

PHOTOSHOP USING A TEXTURED ART BORDER

Having created a Textured Art Border from the previous worksheet – follow these instructions to apply it to an image:

1. Open the Textured Art Border that you created and also the image you want to apply it to. If necessary, rotate the border so it is the same way round as the image.
2. With the **Move Tool** drag the image into the Textured Art Border.
3. Using Free Transform, **Ctrl + T**, resize the image so it is very slightly larger than the black area of the border – remember to hold down the **Shift** key as well to keep the image in proportion. When you are happy press **Return**.
4. In the Layers Pallet there will be two layers; **Layer 1** and the **Background**. Unlock the **Background** by right clicking on it and choose the option **Layer From Background** – click **OK**. Change the **Blending Mode** of this layer to **Screen**.
5. Drag **Layer 1** below **Layer 0** (previously the Background). The image will now be visible through the border. Finally reposition as necessary using the **Move Tool**.

Hint

If you want to have a black border rather than white, simply invert the border by going to **Image > Adjustment > Invert** and change the **Blending Mode** to **Multiply**.
