## PHOTOSHOP SHORTCUTS

## Although not essential, learning a few shortcuts can save time, and make your workflow more fluid and spontaneous

## Below are the ones I use the most:

**Ctrl** and **+ or -** Increases / decreases the image size

] and [ Increases / decreases the brush size

**Space Bar** Brings up the hand tool

**Ctrl** and **t** To enter "free transform"

**Ctrl** and **I** Brings up the "levels" dialog box

**Ctrl** and **c** Copies the current selection

**Ctrl** and **h** Hide / show marching ants

**Ctrl** and **v** Pastes copied selection onto a new layer

**Ctrl** and **z** To undo the last operation

**Esc** Will undo the crop or transform operation before the return

key is pressed

## My favourite one, although not technically a shortcut:

To reveal any burnt out highlight and blocked shadow areas in an image

Just hold down the **Alt** key while adjusting the highlight and shadow sliders in Photoshop's levels
